Review of submitted/revised Horton Rd. Trail Plans

John Worden presented the revised plans that were submitted to the State for the Horton Rd Trail. There was a holdup do to several areas where the required 12 feet width was not possible. Had to be shorten to 10 feet, these areas are noted on the plans. Mr. Ripstra has sent the plans to the State and is looking to get bids out for the project this spring. Mr. Worden stated Jack Ripstra will be working with Mr. Rudolph to make sure all requirements for the project are on track, with the ordering and putting up signs for the project as required by the State along with the distribution of monies.

Open discussion on the sections the city will handle and Summit. Question about getting the permission for a 10 feet wide path instead of 12 feet, and could they come back later and ask to comply. In the long range would it affect further development of the path Worden said once State approves the plans it cannot come back later and have them change it. Mention of the

path the city has already completed on Brown St. was done using cement, and the specifications for the Summit trail will be bid using asphalt.

Jim Guerriero would like to be notified to attend the meeting when Mr. Ripstra gets the bids.

Other Business:

Mr. Worden would appreciate the support for the maintenance of the Spring Arbor Rd. path to be first on list this summer for maintenance and repaving of some areas.
