The meeting was called to order by K. Rudolph, on Monday May 15, 2017 at 7:00 pm in the Township Hall Meeting Room.

A motion was made by Jim Guerriero, to accept the minutes of the February 20, 2017 as written, seconded by Mike Greanya. Motion carried unanimously.

### **Bids Horton Rd Trail**

Rudolph stated the bids were submitted and Quality Asphalts bid was selected at the May 9, 2017 Summit Township Board Meeting, with total bid of \$117,459.35 and a 5% bid deposit. The DNR has been informed and same day both were approved.

### **Horton Road Trail Implementation Schedule**

Horton Road Development Implementation Schedule is in place and up to date. The contract has been awarded, and the DNR has been notified of the approved contractor. Guerriero stated that it sounds like Kibby Rd. will not be completed until the fall. Willard heard that the project will not start till after July 4, due to fireworks at Sharp Park and other activities.

### **Spring Arbor Road Proposed Maintenance**

Chairman has received the proposal concept from Ripstra & Scheppelman, for the overlay to fix Spring Arbor Rd Trail from Lumen Christi to Polly's. Cost is \$40,000.00 just for the overlay. There is not enough to widen the trail, also. Future project: A Trail on North side of sidewalk on McDevitt Rd. to feed into trail to Cross I-27

### **Other Business**

Bikes will be available Friday at the Trail heads, and also at the Teft and Weatherwax Trail Heads. The county is installing lights. Noted that bike pumps will also be available.

Richard Schisler was present in the audience. He would like to have a bench put on the trail with a plaque with his parents name on it. Guerriero informed him that there is a 4 page form that has to be filled out to get permission to have a plaque or memorial of any kind. The form can be obtained through the Jackson County Parks Commission.
